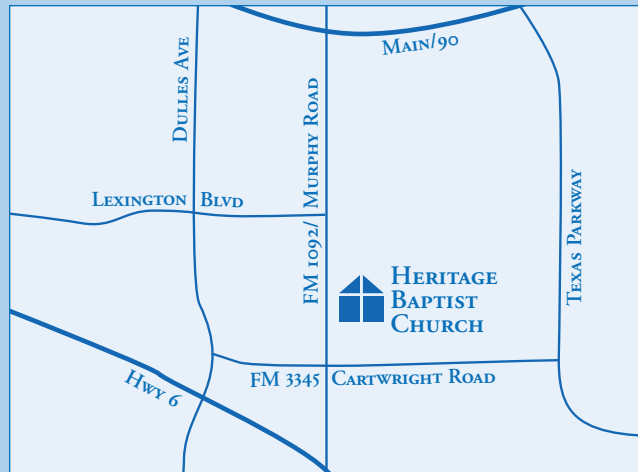


WELCOME

– SENIOR PASTOR

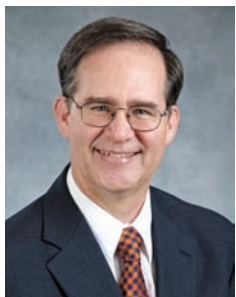
Pastor Charles Murphy has dedicated his pastoral ministry to serving God's purposes.
